STUDENTS RESPONSIBILITIES

2. **Only English should be spoken within the school premises. English has today become one of the major language of the world, and we can neglect its study only at the risk of loss to ourselves.**
3. **The school is ours. It belongs to each one of us. Do not damage property/ furniture or write on the walls. Be proud of your school.**
4. **Cyclist must not ride in the compound.**
5. **Student should not use Mobile in the school campus. If in any surprise checking mobile are found with the student then a charge of Rs. 200/- will be imposed on the concerned person.**

PARENTS SCHOOL RELATIONSHIP

It is the duty of the parents to see the daily diary and sign the remarks. The Unit PA (I, II, III, IV) & Term I & II report etc. should be scrutinized and signed by Parents/Guardians.

1. **Parents should also keep an eye on late attendance reports students absenting themselves for more than two days should submit a leave letter signed by the parents to the Principal.**
2. **No Child suffering from a contagious or infectious disease shall be permitted.**
3. **Parents/Guardians or other person are not allowed to see the children during school hours.**
4. **Parents are requested to attend all Parents Meeting to know the it child's performance.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. (a) **Uniform:** It is compulsory for the students to come in proper & neat uniform every day.
(b) **Students must always come to school in school in uniform as per the dress code. They must come to school neat and tidy.**
(c) **Parents/Guardians are strictly not allowed to enter in the class.**
 2. **Boys should have their hair well groomed.**
 3. **For girls Jewellery should be avoided. Only simple earrings are allowed.**
 4. **Nails should be properly trimmed. Use of nail polish is forbidden.**
 5. **Students who came late or absent themselves must bring written explanation from the parents in diary.**
 6. **Student's absence should be informed in advance through a leave note. Students coming without leave note will not be allowed.**
 7. **Students must obey the class leaders appointed in the absence of teachers to maintain discipline and good order.**
 8. **Damage done to the school property must be made good by the students who were responsible. Parent's must check the diary regularly and note teacher's remarks etc.**
 9. **Annual Examination for promotion to next class is held in March. Students who were weak in any subject in the exam will have to give retest on concerned subjects.**
 10. **No concession in any fee is recommended.**
 11. **Tuition fee must be paid up to the last day of the running month or else fine Rs. 10/- per day would be imposed essentially.**
 12. **Parents/Guardians are requested to inspect school diary and progress report of the student regularly.**
 13. **Fee once paid will not be refundable. Either admission fee or the monthly fee.**
 14. **None of the students are allowed in the school premises in civil uniform.**
 15. **Inside the campus parents/guardians must keep their cell phone in Vibration mode.**
 16. **If any student is having contaminated disease than he/she has join the school after doctor's certificate.**
 17. **The complaints regarding the school management and student conduct shall be discussed only with the Principal.**
 18. **The District Court of Sagar shall be the tribunal of any dispute regarding the institution.**
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GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

Parents should carry out their responsibilities as educator in instilling in their children respect and strict obedience for all school rules and regulations.

1. Students should always wear their School ID card.
 2. Parents are requested to go through their wards school diary regularly and sign the teacher's remarks. If any.
 3. Children should do their home work by themselves unless they require some guidance.
 4. For the best result parents must motivate and support their child establish a proper study area. Home work must be given a priority in the daily schedule.
 5. In case home work has not been completed by the due date then it should be communicated clearly to the class teacher with reason that why the work was not done.
 6. Parents are requested not to accompany their wards to the class rooms at arrival time. At dispersal time they should collect their wards from the school gate.
 7. Parents are also requested to ensure that their wards do not bring gift expect to offer for distribution on birthdays. Students from class VI onwards should be in school uniform even on their birthday.
 8. Parents are requested to refrain from sending lunch boxes/ notebook of their wards during school hours.
 9. Parents are requested to inform the school if there is any change in address/ Tel./mobile numbers.
 10. The school has a system of fruit break for junior classes. You are requested to ensure that the child carries at least **one fruit every day**.
 11. Please do not give mobile phone to your child. If student is found carrying a mobile phone, It will be confiscated and a heavy fine will be imposed.
 12. The facility of internet is required to monitor the usage of this wonderful technology by your ward so that he/she does not misuse the internet access. it is advisable to route your child's E-mail through your account and share their password. Also keep the computer in a central family location, not in the child's room. The usage of computer should be a family activity.
 13. Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies co-curricular activities and sports.
 14. Parents should acknowledge the circular sent from school in the column provided in the Almanac.
 15. Parents should use the "Leave Record" form in the diary when applying for leave or explaining the absence of their children.
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FORWARD TO THE PARENTS / GUARDIANS

In modern times the school has become the most important agency for format education but the home wields a powerful influence in moulding personalities. Both teachers and parents are equally responsible for the education of the child, so maximum co-operation between the parents and the school authorities is desired to secure all that is best in education of your ward.

For this the diary is the best line between the teachers and the parents/guardians. The parents are requested to go though it carefully and make a diary at the appropriate place. They are also requested to offer their suggestion on the page meant for the purpose.

DISCIPLINE

The following rules of school discipline shall be strictly observed.

1. The student shall be regular and punctual and avail leave of absence only as granted.
2. The student shall be neatly and tidily dressed in the prescribed uniform.
3. The student can only speak English while in the school campus.
4. Student will observe perfect silence and discipline when the class is in progress.

6. Children are strictly forbidden to go out of the school during hours without permission from Principal.

CBSE RULES IN CASE OF ABSENTEEISM FOR STUDENTS OF CLASSES X & XII

Requirement of Attendances

- 1. No student from the school affiliated to the board shall be eligible to take the examination unless he / she has completed 75% of attendance counted from the opening of class X/XII upto the first of the month, preceding the month in which the examination commences, in the subjects of internal assessment**
- 2. Exemption form W.E./Art Education/P & HE may be granted to a candidate on medical grounds provided the application is supported by a certificate given by a Registered Medical Officer of the rank not below that of Asset. Surgeon and forwarded by the Head of the school, with his recommendation.**

CBSE Rules For Condonation of Shortage Of Attendances

- 3. CBSE states that if a candidate's attendance falls short of the prescribed Percentage, the Principal of the school may submit his/her name to the Board provisionally. If the candidate is still short of the required percentage of attendance within three weeks of the commencement of the examination, the Principal shell report the case to the Regional Officer concerned immediately. if in the opinion of the Principal, the candidate deserves special consideraton, he/she may submit her/his recommendation to the Regional Officer concerned not later than three weeks, before the commencement of the examination, for condonation of shortage in attendances, by the Chairman, CBSE, who may orders as he may deem proper.**
 - 4. The Principal may refer a case of shortage of attendance with valid reasons for not recommending the case.**

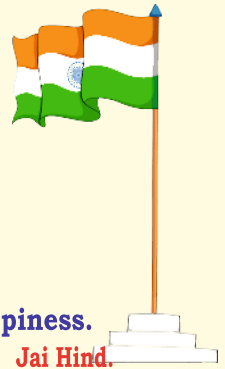
